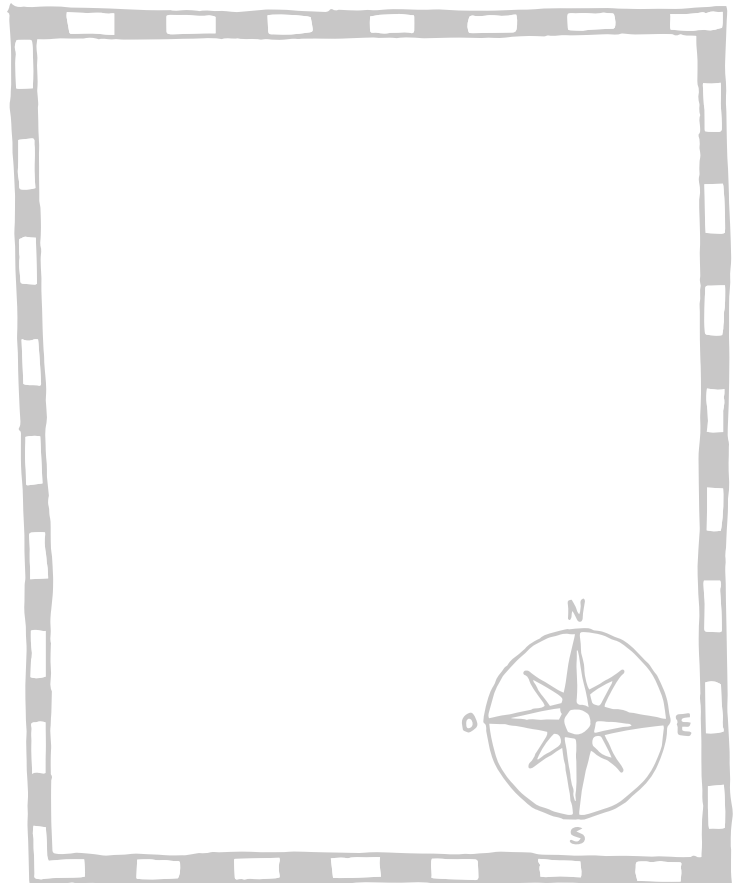


MAP YOUR ROUTE .

Follow the instructions shown on each sheet, collect your paths and share the findings online with the community of strollers using the HT: #BitácoraDePaseo.

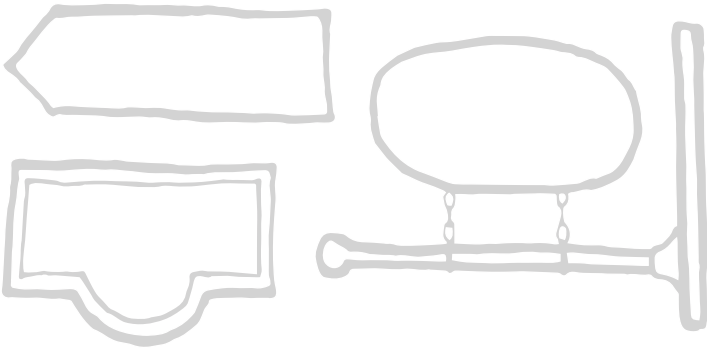
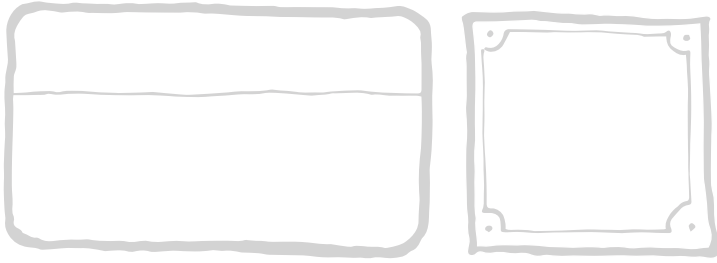
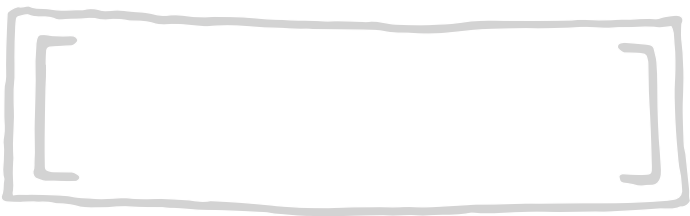

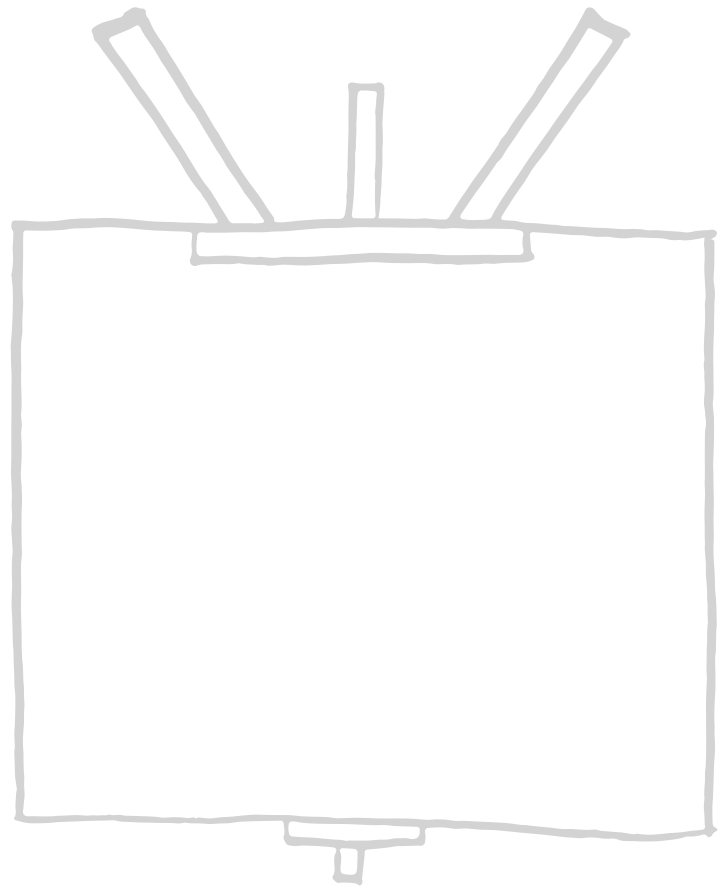

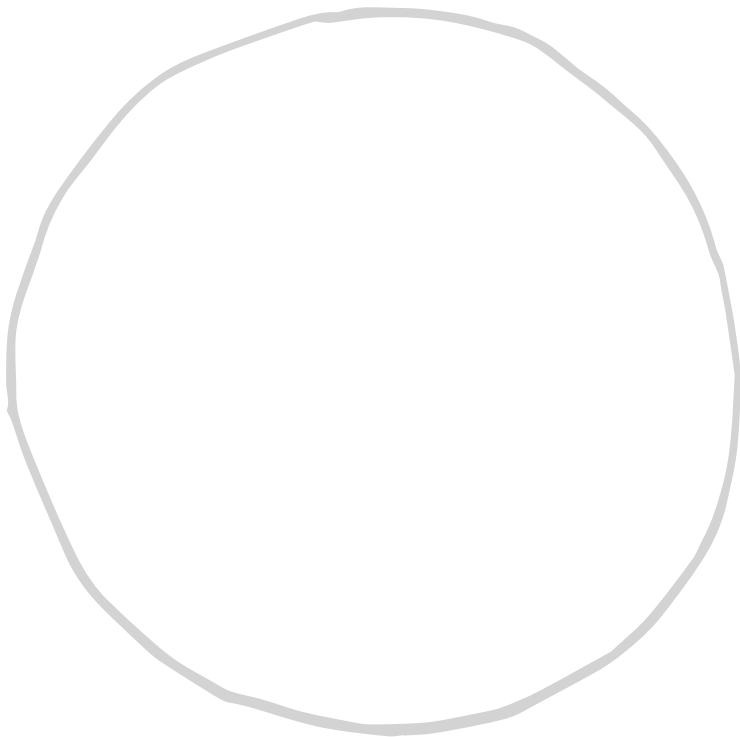


WRITE THE NAMES OF THE STREETS YOU WALKED DOWN.
